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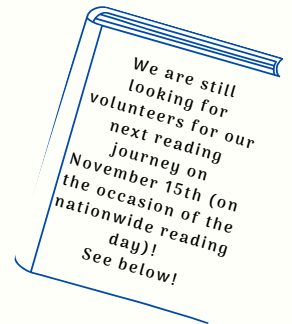
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A look back of the last few months

The fourth-graders had a great time at the reading competition at the end of the school year, listening enthusiastically and attentively to each other and immersing themselves in new book worlds - a true reading festival!

At the end of May, the project week was held again after a five-year break. Under the motto "Our world is colorful," the students had the opportunity to discover the diversity of our world, as the teachers and some parents had prepared a variety of different projects. On Friday afternoon, all families were able to explore the results on a "museum tour" as part of a school festival and chat over coffee and cake.

During the festival, the ceremonial induction into the "School without Racism - School with Courage" network also took place. This network is a project for all members of the school and enables students and teachers to actively shape the school climate by taking a firm stand against any kind of discrimination, bullying and violence. 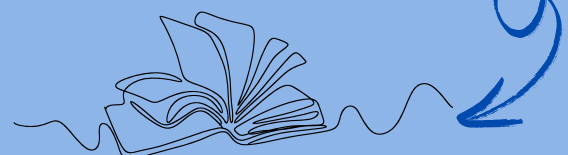
Thanks to the commitment of many parents, we were able to raise €2,000 at the bake sale, which we would like to use for future projects.

Future Projects

A future project initiated by the Förderverein is called "First Responders of Tomorrow". It is a major initiative of the Johanniter that aims to teach important skills and a sense of responsibility. As part of this program, which takes place at the end of January for our third-graders, the students learn not only how to avoid emergency situations, but also how to take responsibility in the community. These skills are crucial to promoting children's safety awareness and social responsibility at an early stage.

In addition, the "Rhythmuspause" will be reintroduced for first-graders from the second half of the year. The rhythm break is a short-term musical intervention that interrupts the daily lessons of a primary school class for twenty minutes. Instead of lessons, the work is done rhythmically: speech rhythms, verses, rhythm language, body percussion, rhythm games and improvisation are the content components of the rhythm break. In recent years, this project of the Frankfurt Music School was financed for all first-graders by the State of Hesse's Löwenstark program. Unfortunately, this year it is no longer possible, but the students and teachers have given a lot of positive feedback. Therefore, as the Förderverein, we would like to make this project possible again for first-graders.

We are also continuing to improve and overhaul the homepage and are working on more intensive cooperation between all school committees, particularly with regard to the future renovation and the associated move. We hope to be able to make more concrete statements on this topic soon.
